

Queen City housing agencies get federal grants

Two housing agencies in Manchester received grants totaling about \$56,000 last week from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development.

The Way Home, a non-

profit organization that assists at-risk or homeless residents in the city, received \$30,412.

Manchester Neighborhood Housing Services, whose focus is on providing affordable housing for low-income families, received \$25,587.

The money is part of \$39.1

million given out across the country by the federal agency to groups that assist families in becoming homeowners.

The grants are awarded through a competitive application process.

Five agencies in the state received grant money.
